Directions/Information



The Hunt Site is located in beautiful Lancaster County Central Park, above is a small map of the immediate area and approach.

If you are coming in the area on U.S Route 30 from the east (westbound) approaching Lancaster PA; (be in the left lane as Route 30 bears off to the right at this junction) exit off Route 30 at Route 462 West (Columbia Avenue), travel about 3 miles to make a left turn onto Lampeter Road south, go to the first traffic light and turn right onto Millport Road, the road snakes around about a mile, take the next left onto Eshelman Mill Road (it's a sharp left), stay to the right at the upcoming "Y" then pass by the Environmental Center and continue on over a steel bridge take the first right to the Kiwanis 22 and the Hunt Site.

If your are coming in from U.S. Route 30 from the West (eastbound) skirting Lancaster PA; exit off Route 30 at Route 462 West (Columbia Avenue), at the bottom of the ramp turn Right onto 462 west, travel about 2.5 miles to make a left turn onto Lampeter Road south, go to the first traffic light and turn right onto Millport Road, the road snakes around about a mile, take the next left onto Eshelman Mill Road (it's a sharp left), stay to the right at the upcoming "Y " then pass by the Environmental Center and continue on over a steel bridge take the first right to the Kiwanis 22 and the Hunt Site.
